The purpose of this study is:

Procedures:

You will be asked to take a 20 minute survey during the first week of the class. Near the end of the class, you will be asked to take a similar survey. Additionally, you will have the opportunity to earn extra credit points by taking a test of programming concepts near the end of the class. (You may choose instead to write a 1 page essay for the same amount of points.)

If you decide to be in this study, your part will involve:

- *Completing two surveys, one at the beginning of class, and one near the end; each survey should take 20 minutes to complete.*
- *Allowing the researchers to see your answers to the test of programming concepts, and selected homeworks and exam questions, but only anonymously.*
- *Allowing the researchers to see the grade you receive in this class, and in the next two CS classes you take (if any) over the next two years.*
- *Allowing the researchers to see your declared major over the next two years.*
- *Participation or non-participation will not have an impact on your grade in the course. The instructor will not know if you choose to participate or not. You may choose to participate in only parts of this study and not participate in other parts.*

Risks/Discomforts

The following risks/discomforts may occur as a result of your participation in this study:

- *You will face no risks in this study beyond those that could occur in attending class or doing homework.*

Benefits

The following benefits to you are possible as a result of being in this study:

- *You are not likely to benefit in any way from joining this study.*

Compensation to You

The following procedures will be followed to keep your personal information confidential in this study:

- *The data that is collected about you will be kept private to the extent allowed by law. To protect your privacy, your records will be kept under a code number rather than by name. Your records will be kept in locked files and only study staff will be allowed to look at them. Your name and any other fact that might point to you will not appear when results of this study are presented or published.*
- *To make sure that this research is being carried out in the proper way, the Georgia Institute of Technology IRB will review study records. The Office of Human Research Protections may also look at study records.*
